Subject: Plant Toxicities

Plant toxicities are challenging to vets as toxins vary with the plant type, the stage of its growing season and the part ingested. Spring flowers, such as tulips, daffodils and narcissus, can trigger intense vomiting, diarrhea and convulsions. Azaleas and rhododendrons cause similar symptoms and can cause death from cardiovascular collapse.
